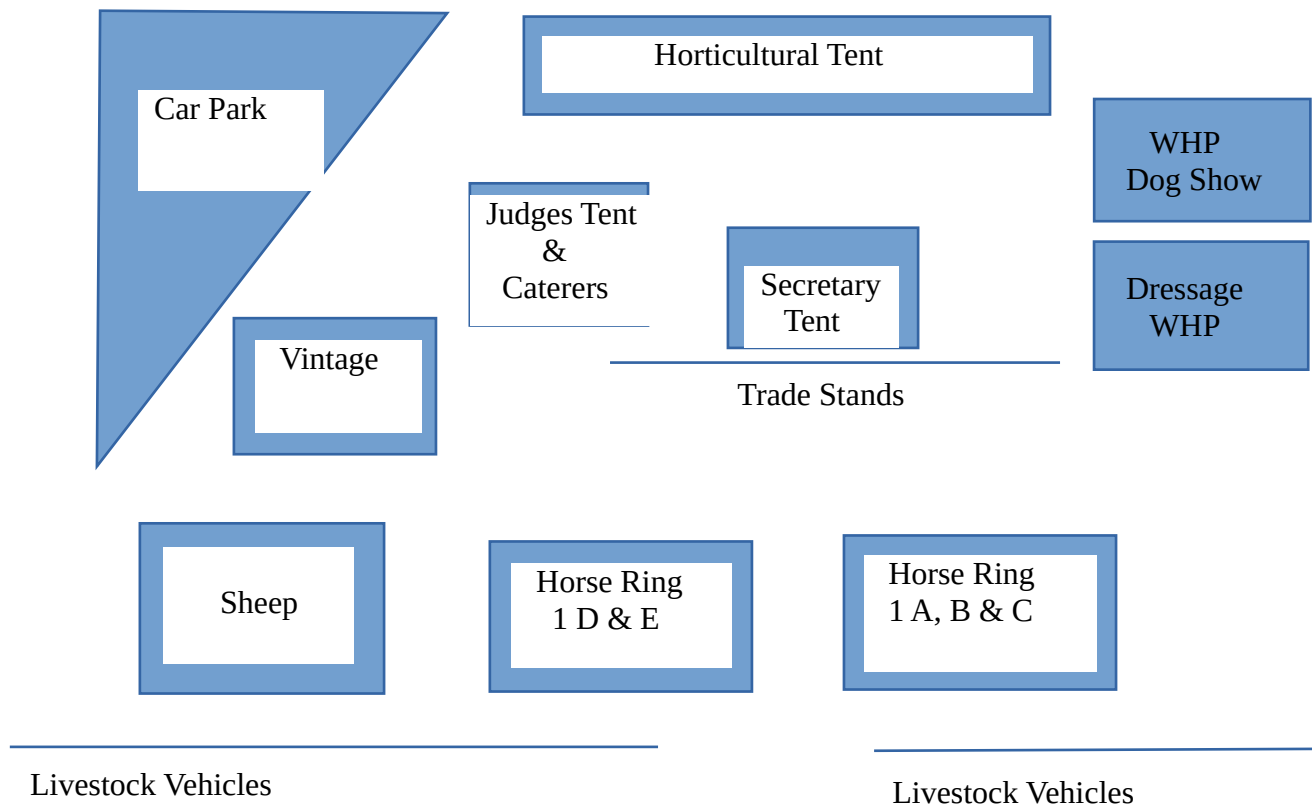

Rheolau ac Amodau/Rules and Regulations

1. That the Society be called The Capel Bangor and District Agricultural and Horticultural Society and consists of President, Patrons, Treasurer, Secretary and members holding its Show at Capel Bangor. The Show to be open to all comers except where otherwise stated.
2. The objects of the Society are to encourage the improvement of Livestock, Agriculture and Horticulture.
3. All exhibits to be bona fide property of the Exhibitor at the time of entry.
4. Any Exhibitor obtaining a prize fraudently will forfeit the whole prize or prizes they may have been entitled to and shall be prohibited from exhibiting in future.
5. Should any dispute arise, the complainant must lodge £5 in the hands of the Secretary, with their written complaint. The Secretary will report such objections to the Committee whose decision shall be final. If the objection is upheld, the deposit shall be returned to the depositor, but if it is considered frivolous the £5 is to be forfeited to the funds of the Society. Protests and objections (if any) must be made before Prize Money is given in the Class to which the objection refers. Complaints in the Horticulture/Produce Sections to be lodged with Horticulture Secretary.
6. The Committee has powers to eject any person from the Show Field who creates a disturbance.

7. All Livestock to be exhibited must be in show field by 9.00am. Judging of Livestock will commence at 9.00am.
8. No exhibit to be removed before 4.00pm.
9. The Committee reserves the right to withhold any prize, if in the opinion of the Judges, sufficient merit is not shown.
10. The Show Field will be open to the Public at 9.00am on payment of £7, children under 14 £3.
11. **TWO ATTENDANTS WITH EACH LIVESTOCK VEHICLE IN THE HORSE, SHEEP SECTIONS WILL BE ADMITTED TO THE SHOW GROUND FREE OF CHARGE.**
12. Exhibitors are prohibited from acting as Stewards for any section in which they have an entry.
13. All Livestock must be under control.
14. Sheep must be shorn bare on or after **1st March** in accordance with the Rules of the Welsh Mountain Flock Book Society.
15. No expense or risk will be incurred by the Society in reception of returning of exhibits.
16. The Society will not be liable for any loss or damage to any stock or article exhibited, for any loss or injury to persons on the Show Field.
17. All Prize Monies to be paid to successful competitors on the day of the Show.
18. Any animal can be entered in as many classes as they are eligible, but will only be allowed to win one First Prize in any particular Section except in Specials and Riding Classes.
19. Birth Certificate of Riders may be asked for in Children's Riding Classes.
20. No Cup is to be engraved without first receiving the permission of the Committee.
21. All horses in the Restricted-to-Height classes, if found above the height defined, will be disqualified. Half an inch allowed in height for shoeing.
22. Please note additional Rules on the page for the Horticulture, Industrial & Handicraft Sections.
23. **All cups to be returned by 1 July 2026, cleaned and polished.**
24. Competitors in the **local classes** must be living within the **Melindwr, Pontarfynach and Blaenrheidol Parishes.**
25. In an event of Show being cancelled competitors who are requesting a refund of entry fees must send a stamp addressed envelope within 7 days of the show being cancelled to the Secretary.

Coffee & Walnut Cake - Ingredients

250g pack softened butter, plus extra for the tins
100ml strong black coffee (made with 2 tbsp coffee granules), cooled
280g self raising flour
250g golden caster sugar
½ tsp baking powder
4 eggs
1 tsp vanilla extract
85g walnuts
2 tbsp roughly chopped, the rest finely chopped

For the filling

100g icing sugar sifted, plus a little extra for dusting
150ml double cream
100g mascarpone at room temperature

Method Step 1

Heat oven to 180c/160cfan/gas 4. Butter 2 x 20cm springform cake tins and line with baking parchment. Set aside 2 tbsp of the coffee for the filling.

Method Step 2

Beat the butter, flour, sugar, baking powder, eggs, vanilla and half the remaining coffee in a large bowl with an electric whisk until lump-free. Fold in the finely chopped walnuts, then divide between the tins and roughly spread. Scatter the roughly chopped walnuts over one of the cakes. Bake the cakes for 25-30 minutes until golden and risen, and a skewer poked in comes out clean. Drizzle the plain cake with the remaining coffee. Cool the cakes in the tins.

Method Step 3

Meanwhile, make the filling : beat together the icing sugar, cream and mascarpone, then fold in the reserved 2 tbsp coffee. Spread over the plain cake, then cover with the walnut-topped cake and dust with a little icing sugar.
